We also hope to take much-needed clothing that the church will then give away to those in need.

How can you help? First and foremost, please pray for the success and safety of the mission trip. Second, please consider donating new or almost new children and adult summer clothing. Items that are especially needed include:

- Infant clothing;

- Running shoes, for ages 10 to 17, for the running club which is organized by the youth pastor.
