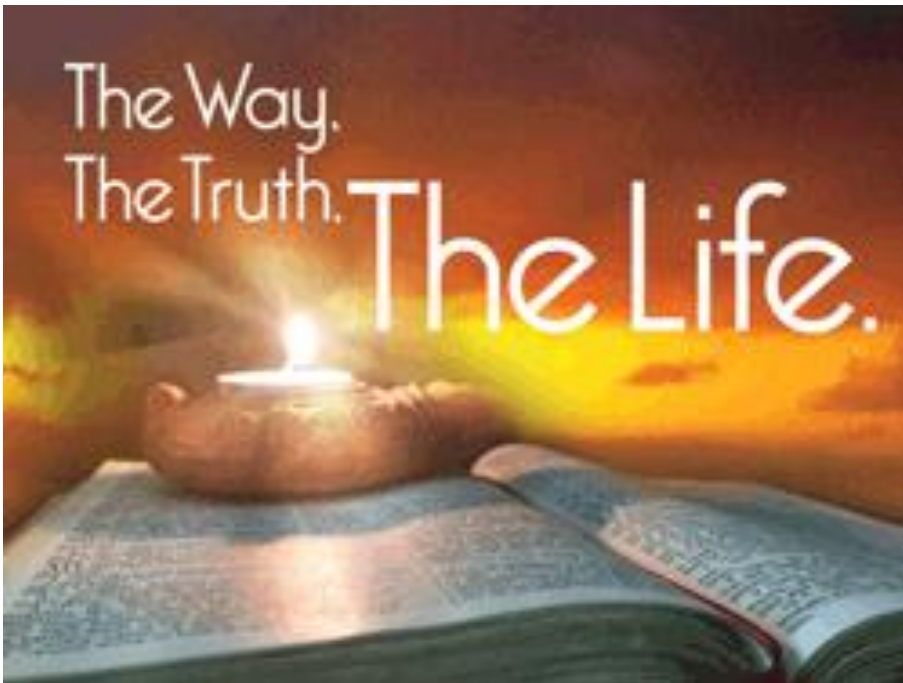

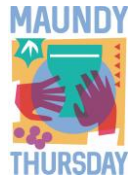
Gospel Passion Readings April 3 through 6
