ANGEL TREE PRISON MINISTRY

This year the Angel Tree Prison Ministry is virtual. Please choose your recipient early as Angel Tree plans to mail out gifts around December 10.

Once you are logged in, eight to ten names of children & caretakers will come up in red. Hit "Show Me More" if you want to see names of additional children. You are allowed 30 minutes to make your choice. The name turns green when you choose who to adopt. Next, go to checkout. The cost for each name is \$42. You can pay with checking, savings, debit, or credit card, but they do not accept PayPal.

Angel Tree will mail your packet to the child of an incarcerated prisoner. It will include a Walmart credit card for \$40, a message from the child's parent, a gospel presentation, and an opportunity to request a free Adventure Bible.
