

## Franconia Baptist Church Covenant (2019)

Having, as we trust, been brought by divine grace to repent and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and to give up ourselves to Him, and having been baptized upon our profession of faith, in the name of the Father and of the Son and the Holy Spirit, we do now, relying on His gracious aid, solemnly and joyfully renew our covenant with each other.

We will aim to glorify and enjoy the God of our salvation, from whom and through whom and to whom are all things. To Him be glory forever.<sup>1</sup>

We will work and pray for the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.<sup>2</sup>

We will walk together in brotherly love, as becomes the members of a Christian Church, exercising an affectionate care and watchfulness over each other, and faithfully admonishing and entreating one another as occasion may require.<sup>3</sup>

We will show perfect courtesy towards all, speaking the truth in love to one another, and avoiding quarrels, gossip, and slander.<sup>4</sup>

We will be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving each other, even as God in Christ has forgiven us.<sup>5</sup>

We will endeavor to bring up such as may at any time be under our care, in the nurture and admonition of the Lord, and by a pure and loving example to seek the salvation of our family and friends.<sup>7</sup>

We will rejoice at each other's happiness and endeavor with tenderness and sympathy to bear each other's burdens and sorrows.<sup>8</sup>

We will seek, by divine aid, to live carefully in the world, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, and remembering that, as we have been voluntarily buried by baptism and raised again from the symbolic grave, so there is on us a special obligation now to lead a new and holy life by the power of the Holy Spirit, as we wait for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ.<sup>9</sup>

<sup>6</sup> **Heb. 10:23-25:** "Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful. 24 And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, 25 not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near." **1Tim. 2:1-6:** "First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, 2 for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. 3 This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, 4 who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. 5 For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, 6 who gave himself as a ransom for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time." **James 5:16:** "Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed.
