### Word & Deed Update - Nicaragua

Nicaragua continues to experience violence and conflict. The socialist government has been forcefully rooting out opposition and over 300 protesters have died. Charitable work with connections to North America is being scrutinized more closely and the leaders of Word & Deed's Agriculture Commercialization Project among the Miskito Indians fear this may affect them. Currently, the areas of the agriculture project have been spared from the worst of the violence and they have been able to continue their work. Please pray that Nicaragua would experience peace and stability and that the Gospel would shine in the darkness there.
