Meditation

CHRIST SPEAKS TO SINNERS

Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David.

Isajah 55:3

Remembering, then, God's gracious and merciful character, and His declared satisfaction with Christ's redemption as the ground of pardon, let us consider the language in which He now speaks to sinners from the mercy seat, and we shall find in His invitations a full warrant for confidence and trust.

Both God and Christ invite sinners to draw nigh, in such terms as leave no room and no apology for refusing. These invitations are frequently repeated, and given in every variety of form, the best fitted to remove our doubts and secure our confidence. They are addressed to *sinners as such* and to *all* sinners, without exception, to whom the gospel is sent, insomuch that it may well be said that if there be a man on earth who is *not* a sinner, to him only are they not applicable – but to every man that is a sinner, *And just because he is a sinner*, they are addressed.

Let us listen, then, to the gracious terms in which God speaks to sinners from the mercy seat, and let us listen to them as if God spoke to us alone: 'Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price...Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David.'
