- **FRC Theological Education Update:** Your Theological Education Committee regrets to inform you that Dr. David Murray has presented his resignation as professor to the Puritan Reformed Theological Seminary board of trustees. The board has accepted this resignation such that his contract is to end July 31, 2020. Dr. Murray feels called to return to pastoral ministry. We are grateful for the ways he was a blessing to the seminary and our students in the past, saddened by this present development, and commend him and the seminary to your prayers for God's blessing in the future. Pray also for the committee as it explores the possibility of nominating to Synod a minister to serve as Free Reformed professor.
