Congregational Life

- Today, Pastor Macleod will lead our worship services.
- Next week, Pastor Macleod will lead our morning worship service, and Dr. Jerry Bilkes will lead our evening worship service.
- The Sunday School & Catechism classes (Beginner – 7th Grade) will meet upstairs this morning for a combined opening. We will have a collection for our sponsor child at this time. The Psalter of the month for November is **Psalter 400:1, 3, & 5**.
- Candidate Benjamin Hicks has received a call from London FRC in Ontario. Pastor John Procee, from Bornholm FRC in Ontario, has received a call from Chilliwack HRC. Please remember them in prayer, as well as Candidate Ben Van Liere and Pastor Macleod, as they consider the calls extended to them.
- **From the Consistory:** Synod 2020 accepted a recommendation from the Theological Education Committee of our denomination to appoint Rev. D. Kranendonk as professor of the FRCNA. Since Synod cannot extend a call, our congregation has been asked to do this on its behalf. To this end, we are scheduling a male membership meeting for **Wednesday, November 4 after our Prayer Meeting to vote to call Pastor Kranendonk to serve as professor of the FRCNA**. If he accepts this call, he will become a minister of our congregation, but all financial costs will be provided by our denomination. After accepting our call, it might be next year sometime before he would move to Grand Rapids and be installed due to immigration.
- **From the Deacons:** As part of the membership meeting on November 4, there will be a request for the congregation to approve roof repairs at the parsonage, as the cost is expected to be over the current approved spending limit. If approved, the **Building Fund collection on November 15** will be specifically designated for this project.
- A preaching station is beginning in Kalamazoo today. At this point, there will only be services in the evening. Dr. Bilkes hopes to preach there this evening, and Pastor Macleod next Lord's Day. We commend this preaching station to your prayers.
