Everyday Worship Reminder

God gives good gifts to His children out of His great love (Matthew 7:7-11). Remember that in Jesus, you can boldly approach God (Hebrews 4:16) and ask Him daily for the things you need. His love for you is everlasting (Psalm 136).

Intentional Activities

All Ages

- Make Cookies - Using any recipe you like, make cookies as a family.
 1. Younger kids love helping dump or pour ingredients into a bowl.
 2. Older kids can help you measure and stir the ingredients together.
 3. As you bake together, talk about how what you are making and how good it will be!
 1. Discuss: The same way that we know how and why we are making these cookies - God made us! He knows how and why He made us.
 2. God made us for a reason! We were made to give Him glory and spread His love across the whole earth!
 4. Share your cookies.
 1. Encourage your kids to consider someone they may want to share their cookies with.
- Kind Cards
 1. Using any materials you have, partner with your kids to make encouraging cards for others you know.
 1. Encourage kids to choose who they'd like to make a card for.
 2. These cards could be for any reason: encouragement, feel better, good job, Happy Thanksgiving, etc.
 2. As you engage this activity, talk about how we love others because Jesus loves us!
- Family Movie Night
 1. Choose a night to set aside for a family movie. You can make it special with forts, special snacks or drinks, or even dressing up!
 2. As you are preparing for your movie night, talk about God's grace and love for us.
 1. God gives us good gifts because He loves us!
 2. God wants us to enjoy Him and each other.
 3. God is always with us in every single moment! He is with us now, and He gave us this moment to enjoy together.
