CALL TO WORSHIP

CONFESSION & ASSURANCE

A call to acknowledge and forsake sin against God and one another, and an invitation to receive the assurance of a new identity in the finished work of Christ.

CONFESSION

LEADER

TOGETHER

But we confess that we have not eagerly maintained our unity and bond of peace, that was bought by your blood and freely given. In our pride we create divisions by wrongly elevating some above others and harmfully amputating those we view as less valuable. We are truly sorry and humbly repent.

LEADER

Jesus, you left the glories of heaven to be with us.

You put on flesh, and with your healing touch reached into our brokenness and longing. You taught us how to live and die as you drank the cup of suffering for us.

You brought us your presence and freely gave us both your life and death.

TOGETHER

But we confess we have simply become like the world, desiring luxury and indulgence, and loving what it loves. We have turned inward and withheld our presence from the world. Out of fear, we have built walls between us and the needs of others, neglecting to offer the grace and presence of the true life you offer. We are truly sorry and humbly repent.



ASSURANCE

LEADER

In Christ, your trespasses were nailed to the cross—you are forgiven, and all your debts canceled.

Jesus has triumphed over all rulers, authorities, and spiritual darkness.

You are now dead to sin, and raised alive together with Christ.

You are the children of God, beloved of the Father—with a future and a hope.

You are His ambassadors carrying His message of reconciliation to the world.

TOGETHER We are the body of Christ. His presence in the world.
