After all, it is your patience and kindness that leads us to repentance. God of mercy, have mercy on us.



ASSURANCE

LEADER

People of God! Jesus loves you and has freed you from your sin by his blood. Your guilt is, once and for all, covered by the cleansing blood of Jesus. Righteousness and life has been freely given to you because Christ bore the punishment for your sin.

IFADER

Look toward Jesus, your mediator, with hope and gladness. He has clothed you in his righteousness. If you are in Christ, your name is written in the book of life and you will one day enter into the everlasting joy of your Father in heaven.
