Jesus, you have called us to love you with our whole heart, mind, soul and strength and to love our neighbor as ourselves, but we confess many times and in many ways we have not lived this way. Lord have mercy on us.

Christ have mercy, and forgive us our sins.

(Leader call for the people to bring their confession of sin to God, and pause in silence).

ASSURANCE

LEADER

For all who put their hope in the finished work of Jesus, hear your assurance-

Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised and is at the right hand of God, interceding for you.

In Christ you are more than conquerors through him who loved you.

And I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate you from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.
