

Frequently Asked Questions

Frequently asked questions concerning children's ministries returning to services onsite.

General Questions:	Answer:
Are masks required for my child to attend kids services?	All children are welcome to wear a mask/face covering to our kids services. We welcome, but are not requiring our children 10 yr and older to wear their mask/face covering while traveling to their seats, during small group and in public areas. Face coverings can be removed once they are in their seats.
Does the children's ministry have masks if needed?	Yes, we have a very limited supply available at our check in desk located in the foyer. We encourage kids to bring one from home.
What should I expect when checking my child in to services?	All children will wash their hands and have their temperature taken before they enter our service/nursery rooms.
Where will we check our children in?	We have moved our check in to one location in the church foyer. We will be using our NEW Simple Church app and this will be a hands free check in for parents. Make sure your Simple Church profile is up to date!

Where are services meeting?	Nursery (3mo-3yr) - Meeting in room #104 the treehouse (Mouse House 3yr-PreK) - Meeting in room #106. Age by 9/1/20. The Clubhouse (BDH K-6th) - St. Timothy Ministry Center (TMC) gym.
How are you social distancing in the services?	We are physically distancing our chairs and floor seating areas.
What are leaders doing to protect my child while at church?	ALL Clubhouse leaders will have their temperature's taken before they serve. Leaders will wash/sanitize their hands frequently during the service and wear their mask/face covering when they are leading in a small group setting where physical distancing is more challenging.
Cleaning Questions:	Answer:
How are you maintaining a safe environment in the children's rooms?	We are cleaning toys and high touch points in between services and deep cleaning after services. We will be cleaning or switching chairs between services in kids church.
