# GUIDELINES

Families please sit together, keeping in mind the 6-foot distancing between family units. Please keep your children and youth in your immediate presence.

Everyone not with their immediate family will need to sit with 2-3 chairs separating you and the next person.

Everyone is encouraged (by state recommendation) to wear a face mask. Face masks will be available at entry points if you do not have your own but want to wear one.

Until further notice, coffee will not be provided. You are welcome to bring your own coffee into the overflow areas (still no food or drink in the worship center).

At the conclusion of the service, you will be dismissed by rows to prevent congestion in the foyer areas. Once outside the building, conversations are encouraged while keeping in mind the 6-foot distancing guidelines.
