

Bolivia Church Plant Update

Last year, Grace Fellowship, in coordination with our Synergy churches, partnered with Compassion International to plant Emmanuel Church Turbito in Turbot, Montero, Santa Cruz, Bolivia. The people in this community are extremely poor, with an average household income of \$290 per month. Construction of the church has been completed with around 60 adults and 120 children attending. Please pray for the families of the children, most of them come from broken families. There are cases in which children are living only with their grandparents. Please pray for children as they grow up. The days that they do not come to the center, they sometimes stay home alone. So, the ministry in this community is necessary.
