The Disciples Can "See" That Jesus Is The Messiah

#### Jesus' Loaded Question

Mark 8:22-23 And they came to Bethsaida. And they brought a blind man to Jesus and implored Him to touch him. Taking the blind man by the hand, He brought him out of the village; and after spitting on his eyes and laying His hands on him, He asked him, "Do you see anything?"

#### Jesus' Symbolic Healing

Mark 8:24-26 And he looked up and said, "I see men, for I see them like trees, walking around." Then again He laid His hands on his eyes; and he looked intently and was restored, **and began to see everything clearly**. And He sent him to his home, saying, "Do not even enter the village."

Mark 8:29 = The disciples receive partial sight. Mark 8:31-38 = The disciples don't "see clearly" Pentecost = The disciples "see clearly" The "Outsiders" Don't Know Jesus' Identity Mark 8:27-28 Jesus went out, along with His disciples, to the villages of Caesarea Philippi; and on the way He questioned His disciples, saying to them, "Who do people say that I am?" They told Him, saying, "John the Baptist; and others say Elijah; but others, one of the prophets."

# The Disciples Can "See" Who Jesus Is Mark 8:29-30 And He continued by questioning them, "But who do(you)say that I am?" Peter answered and said to Him, "You are the Christ." And He warned them to tell no one about Him. **Application** 1. We must believe that only God can open spiritually blind eyes. 2. We must understand that Jesus protects His sheep by allowing them to "see" until He returns. 3. We must believe that Jesus fulfills all the requirements for being the Messiah. 8 Only God Can Open Blind Eyes Deuteronomy 29:4 Yet to this day the LORD has not given you a heart to know, nor eyes to see, nor ears to hear.
