The Two Witnesses Come to Restore All Things

Revelation 11:3-4 “And I will grant authority to my **two witnesses**, and they will prophesy for twelve hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth.” 4 These **are** the **two olive trees** and the two lampstands that stand before the Lord of the earth.”

Zechariah 4:2-3 He said to me, “What do you see?” And I said, “I see, and behold, a lampstand all of gold with its bowl on the top of it, and its seven lamps on it with seven spouts belonging to each of the lamps which are on the top of it; 3 also **two olive trees** by it, one on the right side of the bowl and the other on its left side.”

1. The 1260 days are simultaneous with the trampling of the holy city 11:2.
2. Their prophecy is simultaneous with the reign of the beast during the Great Tribulation (11:7; 13:5).

Two Witnesses Like Moses + Elijah

Revelation 11:5-6 And if anyone wants to harm them, fire flows out of their mouth and devours their enemies; so if anyone wants to harm them, he must be killed in this way. 6 **These have the power to shut up the sky, so that rain will not fall** during the days of their prophesying; and they have power over the **waters to turn them into blood, and to strike the earth with every plague**, as often as they desire.

The Beast Murders the Witnesses

Revelation 11:7-9 When they have finished their testimony, **the beast that comes up out of the abyss** will make war with them, and overcome them and kill them. 8 And their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city which **mystically** is called Sodom and Egypt, where also their Lord was crucified. 9 Those from the peoples and tribes and tongues and nations will look at their dead bodies for three and a half days, and will not permit their dead bodies to be laid in a tomb.

Revelation 11:10-12 And **those who dwell on the earth** will rejoice over them and celebrate; and they will send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented **those who dwell on the earth**. 11 But after the three and a half days, **the breath of life from God came into them**, and they stood on their feet; and great fear fell upon those who were watching them. 12 And they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, **“Come up here.”** Then they went up into heaven in the cloud, and their enemies watched them.

Jerusalem Repents?

Revelation 11:13-14 And in that hour **there was a great earthquake**, and **a tenth of the city fell**; seven thousand people were killed in the earthquake, **and the rest were terrified and gave glory to the God of heaven**. 14 The second woe is past; behold, the third woe is coming quickly.

Ezra 1:2 Thus says Cyrus king of Persia, “The LORD, **the God of heaven**, has given me all the kingdoms of the earth and He has appointed me to build Him a house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah.”

The Future Restoration of Israel

Zechariah 12:9-10 “And in that day I will set about to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem. 10 **I will pour out on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the Spirit of grace and of supplication**, so that they will look on Me whom they have pierced; and they will mourn for Him, as one mourns for an only son, and they will weep bitterly over Him like the bitter weeping over a firstborn” (cf. Ezek. 37; Rom. 11:26-28).
