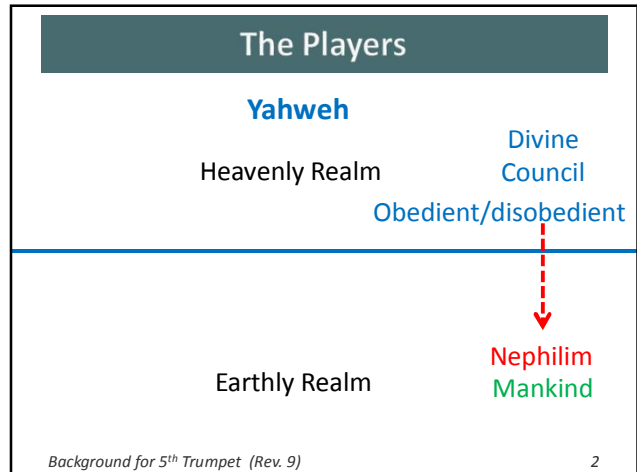

Genesis 6:1-4 Now it came about, when men began to multiply on the face of the land, and daughters were born to them, 2 that **the sons of God** saw that the daughters of men were beautiful; and they took wives for themselves, whomever they chose. 3 Then the LORD said, “My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, because he also is flesh; nevertheless his days shall be one hundred and twenty years.” 4 The **Nephilim** were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, **when the sons of God** came in to the daughters of men, and they bore children to them. Those were the mighty men who were of old, men of renown.

Genesis 10:6-11 The sons of Ham were Cush and Mizraim and Put and Canaan. 7 The sons of Cush were Seba and Havilah and Sabtah and Raamah and Sabteca; and the sons of Raamah were Sheba and Dedan. 8 Now Cush became the father of **Nimrod**; **he became a mighty one on the earth**. 9 He was a mighty hunter before the LORD; therefore it is said, “Like Nimrod a mighty hunter before the LORD.” 10 The beginning of his kingdom was **Babel** and Erech and Accad and Calneh, in the land of Shinar. 11 From that land he went forth into **Assyria**, and built Nineveh and Rehoboth-Ir and Calah...

Judgment of the Genesis 6 Fallen Angels

Jude 5-7 Now I desire to remind you, though you know all things once for all, that the Lord, after saving a people out of the land of Egypt, subsequently destroyed those who did not believe. 6 And angels who did not keep their own domain, but abandoned their proper abode, He has kept in eternal bonds under darkness for the judgment of the great day, 7 just as Sodom and Gomorrah and the cities around them, since they in the same way as these indulged in gross immorality and went after strange flesh, **are exhibited as an example in undergoing the punishment of eternal fire.**

Similarities Between Jude and 1 Enoch

1 Enoch 12:4-5a declare **to the Watchers** of the heaven **who have left the high heaven**, the holy eternal place, and have defiled themselves with women, and have done as the children of earth do, and have taken unto themselves 5 wives...

Jude 6a And **angels who did not keep their own domain, but abandoned their proper abode...**

1 Enoch 10:4, 6 And again the Lord said to Raphael: 'Bind Azazel hand and foot, and cast him **into the darkness...** that he may be sent into the fire on **the great day of judgment.**

Jude 6b He has kept in eternal bonds **under darkness for the judgment of the great day,**

Similarities Between Jude and 1 Enoch

1 Enoch 1:9 And behold! **He cometh with ten thousands of His holy ones to execute judgement upon all**, and to destroy all the ungodly: **and to convict all flesh** Of all the works of their ungodliness which they have ungodly committed, and of all the hard things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him.

Jude 14-15 It was also about these men that Enoch, in the seventh generation from Adam, prophesied, saying, "Behold, **the Lord came with many thousands of His holy ones, 15 to execute judgment upon all, and to convict all the ungodly of all their ungodly deeds which they have done in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him.**"

2 Peter 2:1-4 But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will also be false teachers among you, who will secretly introduce destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them, bringing swift destruction upon themselves. 2 Many will follow their sensuality, and because of them the way of the truth will be maligned; 3 and in their greed they will exploit you with false words; their judgment from long ago is not idle, and their destruction is not asleep. 4 For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to pits of darkness, reserved for judgment;

1 Chronicles 1:13-14 **Canaan** became the father of Sidon, his firstborn, Heth, 14 and the **Jebusites**, the **Amorites**, the Gergashites...

2 Samuel 5:6-7 Now the king and his men went to Jerusalem against **the Jebusites**, the inhabitants of the land, and they said to David, "You shall not come in here, but the blind and lame will turn you away"; thinking, "David cannot enter here." 7 Nevertheless, David captured the stronghold of Zion, that is the city of David.

David + Solomon Conquer the Nephilim

2 Chronicles 8:4-8 He also built upper Beth-horon and lower Beth-horon, fortified cities with walls, gates and bars; 6 and Baalath and all the storage cities that Solomon had, and all the cities for his chariots and cities for his horsemen, and all that it pleased Solomon to build in Jerusalem, in Lebanon, and in all the land under his rule. 7 All of the people who were left of the Hittites, the **Amorites**, the Perizzites, the **Hivites** and the **Jebusites**, who were not of Israel, 8 namely, from their descendants who were left after them in the land whom the sons of Israel had not destroyed, them **Solomon raised as forced laborers to this day.**
