**The Extent of the 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl**

- Each “7<sup>th</sup>” of the Seal and Trumpet judgments open up to the next series of judgments.
- The 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl is depicted as extending into the eternal states (Rev. 22:5).
- This is synonymous with the everlasting nature of the “broad day of the Lord.”

Revelation 16:21 And huge hailstones, about one hundred pounds each, came down from heaven upon men; and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, because its plague was extremely severe.

Exodus 9:23-24 Moses stretched out his staff toward the sky, and the LORD sent thunder and hail, and fire ran down to the earth. And the LORD rained hail on the land of Egypt. 24 So there was hail, and fire flashing continually in the midst of the hail, very severe, such as had not been in all the land of Egypt since it became a nation.
