In light of the current COVID-19 conditions, the faculty and administration have been meeting daily to prepare for the upcoming school year. It is our sincere desire to meet the needs of *all* of our families. In addition to our plans to reopen our traditional classroom setting, we have chosen to offer a virtual option for the upcoming school year. Please review the following plan, being mindful that this is a developing situation needing constant re-evaluation.

Instructional Options

1. Traditional Classroom

- a. On Campus
- b. Face-to-face interaction with the students and teachers
- c. Traditional school schedule
 - * School will begin daily at 8:15 and will be released daily at 2:00 p.m. to allow teachers and staff to sanitize and prepare for the next school day.
 - * Please note that morning care arrival times may be adjusted so that students can report directly to their rooms upon arrival.
- d. After school care available

2. Virtual Classroom

- a. Students will be provided with live videos of the instructional portions of class time.
- b. The academic load will remain the same for students enrolled in both the Traditional Classroom and the Virtual Classroom. All tests, quizzes, projects and reports must be completed.
- c. Student/Teacher help can be scheduled by appointment.
- d. A nine-week commitment is a requirement for this option.

QUESTIONS

1. If I choose the traditional method and my child has to be quarantined, what will happen?
Your child will transition to the Virtual Classroom until he/she has fulfilled the quarantine requirements and is able to return to the Traditional Classroom.
2. How will grading work?
Grades will counted and recorded regardless of which option is chosen.
3. What is the cost for both methods of instruction?
The cost will remain the same for both methods as the school's operating costs have not changed.
