

HE LIVES TO HEAL THE BROKEN-HEARTED

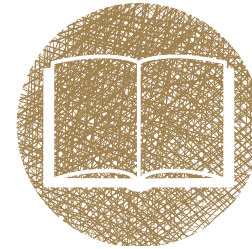
