A.W. Tozer wrote in *Keys to the Deeper Life* that "to speak of the 'deeper life' is not to speak of anything deeper than simple New Testament religion. The deeper life is deeper only because the average Christian life is tragically shallow."

Salvation puts us into vital relationship with Jesus Christ. "For if we have been planted together in the likeness of His death, we shall be also in the likeness of His resurrection: Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin." [Rom. 6:5-6] Jesus said, "I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly." [John 10:10] All in all is Jesus, and Jesus is everything.

Sadly, however, it seems that in our day, Jesus is not enough. The flesh denies something more than simply resting in the finished work of Christ and obeying His Word. "If ye love Me, keep My commandments." [John 14:15]

"For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments: and His commandments are not grievous." [1 John 5:3] Knowing, believing and obeying His Word are paramount to growing in grace and faith and experiencing consistent victory over sin, hence the so-called "deeper life." There is no spiritual life without knowing Christ, and Christ can only be known through His Word. "But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name: Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, [and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,] full of grace and truth." [John 1:12-14]

Even some who minister the Word of God seem to think that something more is needed. Their lack of confidence in the sufficiency of the Scriptures and

the power of the Holy Spirit causes them to resort to other means in an attempt to bolster the Word. None of those things, however, will suffice.

God has chosen the means or the method by which He accomplishes His work on earth. Paul declared, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ; for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth..." [Rom. 1:16] Our English word dynamite is a derivation of the Greek word for power.

"For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God." [1 Cor. 1:18] God does all things by and through His Word. He spoke the worlds into existence. We are saved by the regenerating work of the Holy Spirit by the Word of God. "Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the Word of God, which liveth and abideth forever... the Word of the Lord endureth forever. And this is the Word which by the gospel is preached unto you." [1 Peter 1:23-25]

The Word of God—understood, applied and obeyed—is the only route to spiritual fullness and blessing. "Nothing less than a whole Bible can make a whole Christian." [A.W. Tozer]
