Every true follower of Christ realizes the need of spiritual renewal. In salvation we are united in Him, and His Holy Spirit indwells us within [Rom 6:3-5; Col. 1:27; 2:9-10]. As we make our pilgrimage through this sinful world, we daily face spiritual enemies of the soul: the world, the flesh, and the devil.

A. W. Tozer wrote much about the need for revival and spiritual renewal. I came across a tract he wrote many years ago entitled "How to Have a Personal Revival." [I have condensed it from a piece published by the Osterhus Publishing House in Minneapolis, MN, taken from *The Evangelist of Truth*.]

"Any Christian who desires to, may at any time experience a radical spiritual renaissance, and this altogether independent of the attitude of his fellow Christians. The most important question is how?

1. Get thoroughly dissatisfied with yourself. Complacency is the deadly enemy of spiritual progress. When referring to his spiritual life Paul testified, 'I press on toward the mark!' So stir up the gift of God that is in you.

2. Set your face like a flint toward a sweeping transformation of your life. We must throw our whole soul into our desire for God. Jacob cried in prayer: 'I will not let thee go, except thou bless me.' [Gen. 32:26]

3. Put yourself in the way of blessing. There are plainly marked paths which lead straight to the green pastures; let us walk in them. To desire revival, and at the same time to neglect prayer and devotion is to wish one way and walk another. [James 1:6-8]

4. Do a thorough job of repenting. Hasty repentance means shallow spiritual experience. Until we allow the consciousness of sin to wound us, we will never develop a fear of evil. It is our wretched habit of tolerating sin that keeps us in our half-dead condition.

5. Make restitution wherever possible. If you owe a

debt, pay it. If you have quarreled with anyone, go as far as you can in an effort to achieve reconciliation. As fully as possible, make the crooked things straight.

6. Bring your life into accord with Scriptures designed to instruct us in the way of righteousness. [Sermon on the Mount, Eph. 5-6, Gal. 5, Rom. 6, etc.] I recommend that self-examination be made on our knees, rising to obey God's commandments as they are revealed to us from the Word.

7. Be serious minded. Your interior climate is not favorable to the growth of spiritual graces. There must be a permanent improvement in your interior life.

8. Deliberately narrow your interests. If you will narrow your interests God will enlarge your heart. Christ is the essence of all wisdom, beauty and virtue. The mansions of the heart will become larger when their doors are thrown open to Christ and closed against the world and sin.

9. Begin to witness. Find something to do for God and your fellow man. Refuse to rust out. Learn to obey. Take the low place until such a time as God sees fit to set you in a higher one. Back the Lord's work with your money and spiritual gifts, such as they are.

10. Have faith in God. Begin to expect. Look toward the throne where your Advocate is at God's right hand. All heaven is on your side. God will not disappoint you. 'O my soul, wait thou only upon God; for...He only is my Rock and my Salvation...I shall not be moved.' [Ps. 62:5-6]"

May our Lord be pleased to bless His people with power and spiritual zeal.

WISDOM FOR THE HEART

WITH DR. STEPHEN DAVEY

8:00 A.M. AND 11:00 P.M.

Wisdom for the Heart is an international Bible-teaching ministry based on the sermons of Dr. Stephen Davey, founding pastor of Colonial Baptist Church, started in 1986. Thirty-five years later and with a new name, "The Shepherd's Church" oversees the Shepherds Theological Seminary and Wisdom International, all located in Cary, North Carolina. Stephen Davey is the son of missionary parents and was raised to love Christ, His Church, and His Word. In Stephen's last year of high school, he committed his life to serving Christ and prepared for a life of servant-leadership at Liberty University, Tennessee Temple University, Detroit Baptist Theological Seminary, and Dallas Theological Seminary. Following graduation from Dallas Seminary in 1986, Stephen and his family moved to Cary, North Carolina, to plant Colonial Baptist Church where he still serves as the senior pastor. From the beginning, Stephen preached verse-by-verse while Marsha created the nursery and children's programs. In those early days, word of this new church's commitment to Bible exposition spread rapidly around town, and the fellowship was soon overflowing with attendees. Today the Word of God continues to be expounded and applied there under his leadership. In 2014 the church launched the annual National 360 Shepherds Conference for Church Leaders, which allows Colonial the opportunity to mentor churches on a regional and national level.

Thanks to partnerships with several radio networks, *Wisdom for the Heart* is heard on more than 250 radio stations throughout the United States, as well as transmitted to the Middle East (Arabic), Europe (English), Latin America (Spanish), and Africa (Swahili). Spanish programming is currently broadcast on 90 radio stations and can be heard throughout Central and South America, reaching an estimated 70 million people. The people have responded greatly to the teaching of God's Word. The Arabic translations are being aired on stations located throughout the Middle East, covering much of Iraq, Kurdistan, Jerusalem, Jordan, and Palestine, reaching an estimated 10 million listeners daily in their own language. Wisdom's website [wisdomonline.org] now allows listeners to download all of Stephen's messages and sermon transcripts at no charge. Stephen has written numerous books, study guides, commentaries, and booklets. Stephen's newest global initiative is *The Wisdom Journey* which will take the listener through the entire Bible in three years with a 15-minute audio program. These programs, rich with Bible exposition, are designed to help the believer understand the truth of God's Word and apply God's truth with life application. The goal of *The Wisdom Journey* is to equip pastors and ministry leaders around the world with solid Bible exposition in audio, video, and print formats. This project currently in production has recently completed the first thirty-four lessons from the book of Genesis. As God allows, by 2025 they hope to translate, record, and broadcast 780 lessons from Genesis to Revelation into 100 languages.

Stephen and Marsha have been married more than 40 years and have been blessed with twin sons, Benjamin [wife Caroline], and Seth [wife Megan]; daughters, Candace [husband Christian], and Charity; and six grandchildren.
