Dear Praying Friends,

We are now in the USA (Spartanburg, SC). Last Wednesday 25 people - half from the Nuremberg church, half from the Erlangen church - came to the Nuremberg Airport to tell us good-bye. It was so very kind of them. Social distancing was required, and words came only with difficulty. We were deeply thankful, but sorrowful at the same time.

The flight to America was long. We were delighted to be greeted at the Greenville airport by our son, Jeremy, and our daughter, Julianne. For the next several weeks, we will be staying in a house provided by a Christian man.

Two days after our arrival, we called Jeff's mother. She told us "Welcome home", and then followed with, "But that really isn't true, is it? You left your home in Germany." She understood very well. 31 years ago we left home in the USA for the mission field of Germany. Sometime, early along the way, Germany became home to us, and according to Jesus' promise, he gave us a very large spiritual family (Mark 10:29-30). Now the Lord has put us in a new place, and in time, it will become home as well. No doubt we long for our heavenly home with more understanding than before.

We are, as all incoming expats, in 2 weeks quarantine. It really isn't too bad, as we can go to the grocery store and take walks. Afterward we will look for a car, a house, and a new home church. We will also be contacting all of our supporting churches in the coming weeks.

Our Baptist Mid-Missions president, Vernon Rosenau, stepped down from his office yesterday. It was very special that at the 100 year mark of the life of the mission, the outgoing president should be the grandson of one of the original group of BMM missionaries to Africa. We got to know Vernon and his wife, Jan, well. They have had just a marvelous ministry through the years. We feel ourselves very fortunate to have had such fine presidents during all of our 34 years in the mission, including the new one, Patrick Odle. They have all understood how to keep the mission on course. That is an incredible blessing.
