Sermon Title: “The Substitute”

Subject: Substitution

Scripture Reading: John 19:28-42

There are 7 words from the cross, we can see in our text at hand John by inspiration of the Holy Ghost give us 3. The precious angles observed, here are the 7 for your notes.

- 1) Father, forgive them (Luke 23:34)
- 2) Today shalt thou be with me in Paradise (Luke 23:43)
- 3) Women, behold your son (John 19:26-27) *
- 4) My God, My God why have you forsaken me? (Matt 23:46)
- 5) I thirst (John 19:28) *
- 6) It is finished (John 19:30) *
- 7) Father, into your hands I commend my spirit (Luke 23:46)

A) The greatest task ever accomplished in (HIs-Story), he had honored the law in life. In his suffering and death under the wrath of God The Father against the sin of his people, fully satisfying justice.

1. Justice Satisfied, Isaiah 53:4-6
2. Scripture Fulfilled, Psalm 22:15; 69:21 (I thirst)
3. Hell has a burning thirst, Isaiah 5:14/Luke 16:24
4. Let us drink of the water of life and never thirst John 4:14

B) Vs 29-30 A Roman soldiers drink for a parched saviors mouth. To the believer, it is our kinsmen redeemers love to all who believe Ruth 2:14. When Christ had received the sour wine, He cried “It is finished” Bowed his head and died. What was finished?

1. The whole will of God in regard to redemption. (Heb 10:7/Psalm 40:7)
2. The complete work his Father had given him to do. (1 Tim 1:15/Matt 9:13/John 3:16)
3. The Levitical law and all the types and ceremonies (Heb 10:9-14)
4. The righteousness go God performed, perfected and imputed to believers (Rom 3:19-24; 10:4/2 Cor 5:21)

* im-pute /im'pyoot/ Ascribe (righteousness, guilt, etc.) to someone by virtue of a similar quality in another. “Christ righteousness has been imputed to us”

C) What is the proof of all that he came to do was accomplished? What of salvation and eternal life

1. The resurrection from the dead. (Acts 17:31)
2. Salvation and eternal life is the gift of God, not of works on our part but through the Person and work of our substitute, The Lord Jesus Christ (Eph 2:8-9/2 Cor 5:18-21)

D) Substitution one of the major themes of Scripture with many examples, Christ being the greatest. Here are 3 examples.

1. Gen 22:13 Abraham and Isaac/Ram caught in thicket
2. Lev 16:21-22 The Scape-Goat
3. John 18:39-40 You and me are Barabbas and need a perfect "SUBSTITUTE"
