## ***THE GUIDANCE PRINCIPLE – Gal 5:16 “Walk in the Spirit”***

**GOD U and I – DANCE** – “Steps ordered of the LORD” – Ps 37:23

A dual relationship where God leads in a journey of life that aesthetically appears as a “dance” It is the rhythm of relationship with God that produces beauty and witness to onlookers.
