**Sermon Title:** “What is a Sacrament?” (Symbols of Death)

**Scripture Reading:** Exodus 17:1-6/1 Corinthians 10:1-6

**Theme:** The Sacraments are Symbols of Death

**Introduction:** “Baptized with Fire” (Matt 3:11-12/Luke 12:49-50/Matt 10:38-39)

**1. Baptism is a Symbol of Death (OT):**

- a. “All were Baptized unto Moses” (1 Cor 10:2; Ex 14:13-14)
- b. “Baptized...in the Cloud and in the Sea” (Ex 14:24; 15:6; 15:12)
- c. “The deep covered them/sank to the bottom/like a stone” (15:4; 14:28-29)

Note: Baptism means entering into the Covenant Curse of Death. (Rom 6:3)

**2. Your Baptism is a Symbol of Death (NT):**

- a. Baptism has always been a Symbol of Death (Gen 6:17; 7:23/1 Pet 3:20-21)
- b. Baptism in Christ is a Symbol of Death: Purging - Cleansing (Col 2:11-12)
- c. A Visible Word: Baptism Reveals a Covenant Curse (Rom 6:3/Matt 28:19)

Note: Baptism cannot effect/affect salvation - but a new creation can. (Gal 6:15)

**3. Communion is a Symbol of Death (OT):**

- a. “All did eat the same Spiritual Food...and Spiritual Drink” (1 Cor 10:3-4)
- b. “What is it?” The Bread of Life (1 Cor 10:9/Num 21:5/John 6:31-35)
- c. A Visible Word: Communion Reveals a Covenant Curse (Ex 17:1-6)

Note: Communion means feeding from a broken body to give us life (1 Cor 10:4)

**4. Your Communion is a Symbol of Death (NT):**

- a. “This is My body...Broken for You” (1 Cor 10:16)
- b. “What are you waiting for?” This Sacrament is for You (Luke 22:20/Ps 23:5)
- c. “See what the Sign Signifies” A Body Broken for You (1 Cor 11:24-25, 28-29)

Note: If you do not feed on his death by faith...You eat and drink your own:

“Eating and Drinking Judgment” (New Covenant: “Blood - R. / R. / E. / D.”)
