Sermon Title: The Bond Servants Command, “Comfort”

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 40:1-5

1. A needful command. vs. 1-2 (*Historical backdrop*)
 - a. Comfort God’s people. Is. 51:3; 12:1/2 Cor.1:4
 - b. There is a time to comfort. Eccl. 3:1-8/2 Tim. 4:2
 - c. Why comfort is necessary. Eph. 6:12 /Acts 26:18/1 John 5:19

2. A voice crying in the wilderness. vs. 3
(*Future prophecy*)
 - a. Humiliation of some. John 1:11/Is. 53:3
 - b. Exaltation of others. John 1:12
 - c. Revelation of the glory of Christ Jesus. John 1:29

3. The valley, the mountain and the crooked. vs. 4
(*Immutable promise*)
 - a. The broken and contrite, the sick. Ps. 51:17; 34:18/Luke 5:31-32
 - b. The proud righteous religionist. Matt. 23:13-39
 - c. Types, patterns and pictures now plain. Luke 24:27, 44-45

4. The glory of the Lord “SHALL” be revealed. vs. 5
(*Everlasting Gospel*)
 - a. All flesh shall see together. John 17:24/2 Cor. 4:6/Rev. 1:7
 - b. Two mouth’s, one to fall into and one to listen to. Is. 5:14/
John 10:27-28
 - c. The gospel of his glory. 1 Cor. 26-31
