Sermon Title: Are you in Union with the Blessed Man?

Subject: Union with Christ by Faith

Text: Psalm 1:1-6

1. Consider the *perfect* **conduct** of the Blessed Man. Ps 1:1
 - a. The Blessed Man is one who “prospers in the things of God, according to the will of God.”
Gen 26:28; 39:20-23/Ps 128:1-5/Prov 8:32
 - b. No association with the persons or practice of sin. Prov 1:15; 4:14-15; 13:20
 - c. His separation from sin and sinners is perfect: Qal Perfect verb form. Ps 119:1-6

2. Consider the *perpetual* **contemplation** of the Blessed Man. Ps 1:2
 - a. The Blessed Man’s delight: The Law of the Lord. Ps 119:11, 35, 47, 72, 92/Jer 15:16
 - b. The Blessed Man’s devotion: Meditation in the Law of the Lord.
Ps 119:15, 93, 97-99
 - c. The Blessed Man’s diligence: Day and Night. Joshua 1:7-8
 - d. Who does this describe? _____. Ps 40:7-8/Heb 10:5-7/John 17:4/John 19:30
3. Consider the *portrayed* **characteristics** of the Blessed Man. Ps 1:3
 - a. He is Planted Gen 2:8-10/John 3:34
 - b. He is Productive Rev 22:1-2
 - c. He is Preserved Prov 2:8; Prov 16:17/Jude 1:1
 - d. His is Prosperous (certainty of). Gen 39:3, 23/1 Chron 22:11/Dan 6:28/Is 53:10
 - e. It is Prophetically speaking of _____ and _____. Jer 17:5-8/John 15:1-10/Is 61:1-4
4. Consider the **contrast** and the conclusion. vs 5
 - a. An illustration of the wicked Judged... Ps 5:5/Job 21:18/ Is 17:13; 29:5/Hosea 13:3/Matt 3:12
 - b. God’s intimate, covenantal love of the Righteous. John 10:14, 27-30; 17:1-3/2 Tim 2:19
 - c. God’s righteous indignation against the wicked, and reward to those who believe. Ps 2:12/
