- 1) **A personal address to Timothy with exhortation** - v 1
 - a) My son be strong
Psa 119:28/Phil 4:13/2 Cor 12:9-10/Neh 8:10
 - b) In Grace
John 1:14/Psa 85:9
 - c) In Christ
Gal 3:26-28/Rom 8:1

- 2) **Hearing the preacher/Hearing “the establishment of witness”** - v 2
(2 Cor 13:1/Deut 19:15)
 - a) Commit to faithful men
Prov 20:6/Luke 18:8
 - b) Able to teach
Psa 144:1/Rom 12:7/Heb 4:12
 - c) The purpose (others)
Acts 17:11, 17/Rom 10:4/John 9:36

- 3) **Expect war and be ready, know what’s to be expected** - v 3
 - a) From therefore to therefore - Psa 119:33-40
 - b) Endure hardness - kakopathéō (κακοπαθέω) (You have been quickened)
Rom 7/2 Cor 12:9-10/Eph 6:10-18/Neh 8:10
 - c) When is a soldier Good? Prov 8:33; 9:20

- 4) **War needs not entanglement** - v 4
 - a) Affairs of life
Luke 8:14; 21:34/Mark 4:19
 - b) To whom do you seek to please?
Eph 5:8-10/2 Cor 5:9/ (Matt 3:17; 17:5) (Isa 42:1)
 - c) Chosen to be, you had no choice and you love it so
John 15:16/1 Peter 2:9/Deut 14:2 (1 John 4:19)
