Text: Hebrews 11:1-7

1. Seven aspects of faith explicated according to scripture. vs. 1-2
 - a. True biblical faith is (belief) and (_____) in its (substance), the Greek transliteration for substance is (_____) defined in the Greek as;
 1. (foundation), (_____), (_____), or assurance.
The substance is the (foundation) who is (_____) in whom are all things hoped for. – Is. 28:16-17
 - b. Our faith has confidence in the eternity of the unseen. – 2 Cor. 4:18/Rom. 8:23-25
 - c. Faith looks and trust in its source and grows. – Heb. 12:2/2 Thess. 1:3
 - d. The Christian walk testifies to our belief and reverence of God. – James 2:18/2 Cor. 5:6-8
 - e. Salvation comes through faith/Eph. 2:1/John 20:29
 - f. Assurance is found in trusting and believing in the (object) of our hope for justification. – Hab. 2:4/Rom. 1:17/John 1:12
 - g. Faith’s biblical imperative concerning Christ. – John 8:24/Heb. 6:18-19
2. The lives of the Old Testament Patriarchs was witnessed by faith. –vs. 2
 - a. Their lives demonstrated obedience and honor. – Micah 6:8/Jer.7:23
3. The faithful believe the biblical account of universal creation. vs. 3
 - a. Our faith trust in the inerrancy of scripture, if God said it, we believe it. – Ps. 119:160/Gen. 1:1/John 1-3
 - b. Godly belief is manifested in trusting his word. – Prov. 3:5

4. The Holy Spirit's revelation of wonderful models of faith. vs. 4-7
 - a. By faith Abel followed the biblical typology by his sin Offering. – Lev. 1:10/Heb. 9:22
 - b. Enoch's translation demonstrated his faithful dedicated commitment, and trust. – Gen. 5:22/
Ps. 119:105
 - c. Faith is a must to please God. – Gal. 8:22/1 Peter 5:6-10
 - d. Noah's life was consecrated to God by trusting in his word and preaching judgement. – Gen. 6:9, 22
/2 Peter 2:5
