Sermon Title: Wast Angry, “Thanksgiving Song”

Text: Isaiah 12:1-2

1. And in that day, what day?

- a) The day of conviction. Isa 2:10-11/John 16:8
- b) A day of revelation. Isa 25:8-9/Luke 2:30
- c) A day of great assurance. Isa 26:1-4/Matt 28:6

2. The spiritual response is praise! (I will praise him)

- a) His works are marvellous. Psa 9/Psa 139:14
- b) Everlasting love had a “just anger” turn away in a person.
Jer 31:3/Isa 53:11/2 Cor 5:21 (Rom 8:31-33)
- c) We were once without, now we are in. Eph 2:3-4/Eph 2:11-13 (1 Cor 1:30)

3. Look at my God! (Sister Arbis had it right)

- a) Giving praise by song in that salvation is “all of grace”.
Eph 2:8-9 its always been the message.
- b) When salvation is understood properly by Spirit filled conviction, then we can trust Him a right.
Prov 3:5

“Thus, says the LORD,” Let not a wise man boast of his wisdom, and let not the mighty man boast of his might, let not a rich man boast of his riches; Jeremiah 9:23

- c) He is our salvation, Lock, Stock and Barrel, yet it was a process to the point of divine admission.
(He Became) personally and in time, SALVATION. Isa 46:9-11/Rom 11:29
