**Sermon Title:** Mary, The Magnificat – Part 1, “Divinely Impregnated with Promise”

**Text:** Luke 1:26-38

1. A **Salutation** of grace *communicated*. vs 27-30
  - a. The unfolding drama of *redemption*: From Scene 1 to Scene 2. vs 25-26
  - b. “Their *rebellion*” = Mary represented the present condition of Israel. vs 27, 47/Neh 9:17/Eccl 7:20
  - c. A *royal* greeting of sovereign *Grace*. vs 28
  - d. The *reassurance* of a perplexing situation. vs 13, 29-30
  
2. The **Seed** according to promise *conceived*. vs 31-33
  - a. The *Scriptures* fulfilled in and through Mary. Is 7:14/Matt 1:21-23
  - b. He shall possess *Superiority*. vs 32a/Mark 10:42-45/Is 53:12
  - c. He shall be called *Son* of the Highest (of God). vs 32b, 35
  - d. He shall be *Sovereign* King. vs 32b-33/2 Sam 7:12-14a/Ps 89:29
  - e. The *Scope* of his rule – Eternal. vs 33b/Ps 89:35-37/Isaiah 9:6-7
  - f. The *Splendor* bestowed upon Mary, who represents the Bride of
  - g. Christ-the Church. Gen 3:15/Jer 31:22/Rev 12:1-2
  
3. The **Scandal** and miracle of this conception *clarified*. vs 34-37
  - a. Mary’s logical *request*. vs 18, 34
  - b. Gabriel’s *responds* clarifying the miraculous nature of the birth. vs 35/Gen 1:2/Ex 40:34-35
  - c. Mary’s Faith is *reinforced*. vs 25, 36-37/Luke 18:27

Conclusion: The humble **Submission** of Mary’s Faith *committed*. vs 38
