Sermon Title: Protected to Make a Gospel Presentation

Text: Acts 22:1-16

Confusion is always the mark of the – James 3:13-16

Guarded by beast 1 against beast 2: Acts 21:34-40

1. Addressing the charges against him: Acts 22:1-5

a. In defense of the gospel – Acts 9:15-16

b. A respectful introduction – Prov 15:1

c. I was a beast just like you! – vs 3-5/Ps 49:12, 20

2. But I Saw the LIGHT: – vs 22:6-16 “The Apostles conversion and calling”

a. The *Force* of the light – (Noon Day)

b. A light that *humbled* him – vs 7a

c. A light that *spoke to Him* – vs 7b, 9:7-8

d. It was *Christ the light* of the World – vs 8/John 1:4, 9; 8:12

3. A light that changes your whole life: Prov 4:18

a. It *invades* your journey – Prov 16:35

b. It arrests and halts your momentum – 1 Peter 5:5-6

c. It speaks convincingly to your soul – Is 55:1-5/Ps 119:130

d. It affirms Jesus Christ as the central object and subject – 1 Cor 2:2

e. It draws you in exclusively – Acts 9:7/John 6:44-45

f. The expanded version of His testimony – Acts 26:13-14
