

  - Completeness
  - In the NT usually refers to completeness such that there are no gaps, nothing missing (Hoehner)
  - It can describe maturity (Eph 1:23)
- 


# Paul's Third Request

# Paul's Third Request

What does this mean for us?

**Fulness includes:**

- God's power working in the church (1:23)
- The love of Christ (3:19)
- Providing the church with spiritual gifts (4:10)
- Influence and control of the Holy Spirit (5:18)
- Its goal is spiritual maturity of the church (4:13)
