"The human person is a social being, that woman complements man and that man complements woman. In this way human beings reflect God, who exists not as a solitary being but as a being in fellowship"


Women manifest important aspects of God's image

- <u>Compassion</u> from Hebrew word for "womb". Compassion is like the tender care a mom has for her baby.
- Helper woman as man's helper. All 3 members of the Trinity are called our Helper (Ps 54:4; 1 Jn 2:1; Jn 14:16)
- <u>Unfailing love</u> God's unfailing love is expressed as a nursing mother (Isa 49:15)
- <u>Protection</u> God protects as a mother bird protects her chicks (Ruth 2:12; Ps 17:8; Mt 23:37)

God is not feminine, but feminine traits reflect parts of His character

All women are to pursue a rich and faithful ministry in the home life she creates and manages to provide a context for spiritual life and ministry
