Policies and Procedures

Application Process

- Application must be completed prior to start date
- For 12-month/semester interns, Elder approval must be secured
 - Applicant may attend an Elders meeting, be represented by Pastor for Creative Arts in an Elders meeting, or may use Skype/FaceTime to have final conversation with Elders before start date.
- For 10-week interns, Pastor for Creative Arts will make final approval before start date

Office Paperwork

- All interns must complete a background check prior to start date
- All interns must complete a W4 to be included in payroll processing
- Contract must be signed by Pastor for Creative Arts and an Elder prior to start date

Compensation

- 12-month interns will be paid monthly, at the end of the month. Tax withholdings should be communicated to the Business Administrator.
- 10-week interns will be paid at the end of the 10 week period (negotiable)
- Ministry expense reimbursement should be recorded in Expensify (download the app and set up an account). Pastor for Creative Arts will share Personal Reimbursement Policy and will instruct on approved expenses and encourage proper stewardship.
- Conference expenses will be managed by Pastor for Creative Arts. This may include: conference registration fees, lodging, travel, and meals.
 - Potential conferences: Getty Music "Sing" Conference, Doxology & Theology Conference, Linger Conference, The Gospel Coalition, WorshipGod Conference, or others that will serve the intern while fitting in the church calendar of events.

Budgeting

- Creative Arts Internships will be budgeted within the Personnel and Creative Arts budget categories.

Discipline

- If an intern violates their GCC Membership covenant in any way, or is involved in a public sin with public consequences, or is deemed to be hindering the work of the gospel in GCC ministries by any of the staff or Elders of GCC, the intern's contract shall be terminated immediately.
 - For a 10-week intern, the sending institution will be contacted immediately for disciplinary action and the intern must make arrangements to return home or to their sending institution as soon as possible.
