Introduction to Amos:

Seek: *Seek with care, inquire about, investigate; be intent on.*

- I. Seek **ME**, and live (v. 5)
 - a. Turn from False Gods (v.5a)
 - b. Turn from Religion (v.5b)
- II. Seek **The LORD**, and live (6-13)
 - a. Turn to their Covenant LORD vs. (6, 8b, 2:9-12)
 - i. LORD = YHWH.
 - b. Turn to **him**, A refuge from impending judgement. (v. 6b)
 - c. The All Powerful Judge. (v. 8)
 - d. The All Knowing Judge (vs. 7, 10-13)
- III. Seek **Good and not Evil**, and Live (vs. 14-15)
 - a. "That the LORD, the God of Hosts will be with you"
 - b. Hate evil, Love good.
 - c. Establish Justice.
 - d. The hope: God would be gracious.
