**The Harvest is Ready | [John 4:31-35](#)**

In preparation for your home group this week:

Read [John 4:3-42](#)

Vs 4 Jesus “had to” pass through Samaria. Why? The Jordan River valley is easy and much faster than the mountain route through Samaria.

What do you pick up in the attitude of the woman?

How did Jesus respond? How did he lead the conversation?

How did her attitude change during the conversation?

What do you learn from the dialogue between Jesus and the disciples?

What creature comforts keep you from doing the will of God?

If the “field” is truly ripe for “harvest,” what is an appropriate attitude for us as we live each day?

What difference does your approach to someone affect their openness to you and your faith?

Additional passages:

1. Read [2 Corinthians 5:17-20](#). Who are the ambassadors of Christ?
2. Read [1 Corinthians 3:6-8](#). What activities can we do in one’s salvation? What can these activities look like?
3. Read [1 Peter 3:15](#). What question was asked? Who asked the question? What are the implications for you?
