Main Idea: God wants to help us navigate disagreements in a godly way.

Three Primary Truths Regarding Disagreement:

1. Christians can simultaneously be united and divided.
2. Christians need to develop the capacity to agree to disagree.
3. God can use disagreement to further the Gospel.

Four Godly Responses to Disagreement:

1. Acknowledge.
2. Clarify.
3. Negotiate.
4. Unite.
