Review and Discuss...

1. Fellowship Basics

The Greek word for fellowship is Koinonia... Having something in common. Participation. Sharing. Giving.

Koinōnia...19 times in NT. Common sharing in something greater than ourselves.

True Christian fellowship involves common sharing in Christ and common caring for His Church.

1 John 1:3 "that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ."

While we are POSITIONALLY in the same fellowship in Christ as all believers, we primarily EXPERIENCE ongoing fellowship with those we are in close relationship with.

As you faithfully follow Jesus, your relationships should reflect the fellowship you have in Christ with all CHRISTIANS. That will most likely be with a relatively small group of people.
