Talk

1. How do believers know and discern God's will?
2. Who urged Paul to avoid Jerusalem? Why did Paul insist on continuing to Jerusalem? How did the church respond?
3. What hardships might we encounter as we seek to follow God's will?
4. Trace how many times Luke refers to God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit in [Acts 20:1-21:16](#). What does this tell us about submitting to the triune God?
5. Talk about your lives, and specifically, how you can follow God's clearly revealed will, as well as navigate that which is confusing or unclear.
