Hallelujah, our salvation, Jesus Christ is our foundation.

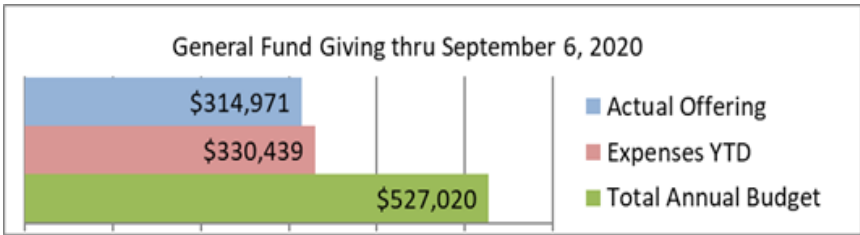
