- I. In the midst of disruption, God does not forsake his people — Isaiah 49:14-16
 - A. He cannot forget his wounds for us — vv. 15-16
- II. Instead of disruption, God has a future in store for us that we cannot even imagine! — Isaiah 60:1-5, 18-21
- III. We must welcome the disruption of our belief system before we can enter the Kingdom of God — Isaiah 45:20-23
