The Unseen Nature of Spiritual Warfare

Daniel 10-12

As we conclude our study in the book of Daniel today, we would do well to be reminded that behind all of the dark realities we face in this life, there is much more that we don't see. That is what Daniel 10-12 will show us today. God sends a heavenly figure to give Daniel a glimpse about what is happening on the battlefield in the spiritual realm. God's people can gain much comfort and clarity in this life as we remind ourselves that our battle is not against flesh and blood but against the principalities of darkness. Daniel is given confidence that God has already won the victory even as the war still rages.

Main Idea:

"As God's people live as pilgrims in a land that is not their home, we must remember that there is more that is unseen than seen in the life."
