THE PLACE

The city

The place where God has called us to minister is one of the major cities of West Africa with a metropolitan population of close to 3 million people. This city is one of the most important cultural, economic and educational centers of the region, and is home to a diverse mixture of peoples whose dominant belief system is Islam. In fact, 95.4% of its population is Muslim, while only 4.2% is Christian (mostly Roman Catholic). It is one of the six largest French-speaking cities in the world. Most importantly, it is also home to the largest population of the unreached people group to whom we hope to minister.



The University

Being the largest and most prestigious university in French West Africa has given

it no small influence on the continent. Generations of graduates have gone on to become presidents, foreign ministers, novelists and professors at universities around the world. With more than 70,000 students from diverse nations including many from unreached people groups, the campus is a naturally strategic context in which to reach and disciple students for Christ.

THE VISION

Our purpose is to come alongside the national Presbyterian church and support their vision for ministry. They have expressed a desire to proclaim the gospel to unreached people groups in their area and a need for a ministry to their college students. As an arm of the national church on campus, our goal will be to bring the two facets of this vision together by reaching students and discipling them toward maturity in Christ.

It is our prayer and hope that these mature Christian men and women can then become servant leaders in their churches and instrumental in reaching their communities with the gospel.



THE STRATEGY

A solid college ministry that is connected to the local church and where the gospel is central, will be strategic in reaching students for Christ and equipping them to serve.

Two Strategic Partnerships

We will be working in partnership with Reformed University Fellowship to establish the first RUF ministry on the African Continent. RUF has developed a philosophy of ministry which is biblically informed, pastorally sensitive and consistent with the God-given role of the Church of gathering and perfecting the saints. It gives particular emphasis to helping students grow in grace, evangelism and missions, fellowship and service, and a biblical world and life view.

Also, as part of our support to the local church, we anticipate collaborating with an MTW missionary family whose work will focus on a center-city church plant among the dominant unreached people group in the region.
