I. Introduction to this Study

Concluding the series of Pray Like Jesus we examine the end of Jesus' prayer, "Yours is the Kingdom and the power and the glory forever."

II. Study the Text

Read Matthew 6.5-13.

- a. The prayer ends with a powerful declaration, the Kingdom is God's not ours, power is God's not the worlds and God is the sole proprietor of glory.
 - i. Ask: What are some things that you feel are yours? Get specific...your kids? Your family? your job? Your church?
