**Life in the Spirit**

***Romans 8:9-11***

1. Life in the Spirit is freedom from the flesh.
2. Life in the Spirit is united with the Spirit.
3. Life in the Spirit binds you to Christ.
4. Life in the Spirit is a result of a spiritual resurrection.
5. Life in the Spirit guarantees the physical resurrection of our bodies.

**Application:** Be Courageous.

## Digging Deeper Into the Message

1 Thessalonians 5:23

*Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.*

2 Thessalonians 2:13

*But we ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers beloved by the Lord, because God chose you as the firstfruits to be saved, through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth.*

Pastor Andy spoke about sanctification and how life in the Spirit unites us with the Spirit.

Hebrews 10: 1-25 describes the completeness of Jesus' sacrifice. In verses 8-14, what does Jesus do?

In verses 19-25 what are we told to do and why?

In Jesus' High Priestly Prayer in John 17, what does Jesus say about and pray for His followers in verses 16-26? What are the "so that...." and other reasons listed after these descriptions?

Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-31, how is Jesus described?

As we depend on Jesus to make us more like Him, meditate on 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 and be assured of His faithfulness.

Challenge: Memorize Philippians 1:6: "And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ."

(and review last week's memory verse, 2 Corinthians 5:17)
