Luke 5:12-16; Luke 8:43-48

### **Summary**

Pastor Danny Bae shows us from the gospel of Luke that Jesus not only physically healed the leper and the woman who was bleeding for 12 years, but He also trades places with the sinner by laying down His life so that their sins could be forgiven. As it says in Isaiah 53:5, by His wounds, we are healed

### **Discussion Questions**

1. Why was the leper prevented from coming into the presence of God? What does this say about God's holiness? How is it then that we as sinners can approach Him?
2. Jesus traded places with sinners as a substitute in life and death. How does that enable you to live faithfully to God?
3. If Jesus' ultimate purpose in healing was to point people to the spiritual healing he would bring, how should we prioritize in the church what is of primary importance?
