# Advent Reading: Galatians 4:1-7 (p. 974)

<sup>1</sup> I mean that the heir, as long as he is a child, is no different from a slave, though he is the owner of everything, <sup>2</sup> but he is under guardians and managers until the date set by his father. <sup>3</sup> In the same way we also, when we were children, were enslaved to the elementary principles of the world. <sup>4</sup> But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, <sup>5</sup> to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. <sup>6</sup> And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" <sup>7</sup> So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.

#### For Further Discussion:

- 1. What similarities and differences do you see between the birth narratives of Isaac and Jesus (vv. 1-4; Lk. 2:1-8)? How are you blessed by the fulfillment of God's promise of a son to Abraham (Gal. 3: 16, 23-4:7)?
- 2. What is the significance of the reference to God's timing in the fulfillment of His promise of son to Abraham and Sarah (vs. 2; Gen. 17:21; 18:10, 14)? How does the Lord's timing factor in the birth of Christ (Gal. 4:4)?
- 3. What is the purpose of God's command to Abraham to name and circumcise Isaac (vv. 3-4; Gen. 17:10)? How does purity of Isaac anticipate the holiness of Christ (Lk. 2:21; 3:22)?
- 4. Why is there repeated references to Abraham's age in Isaac's birth narrative (vv. 5, 2, 7)? How does this one detail about Isaac's birth point the circumstance surrounding the miraculous nature of Christ's birth (Lk. 1:26-38; 2:1-7)?
- 5. How does the Lord change Sarah's laughter at the birth of Isaac (vv. 6-7; Isa. 54:1; Gen. 18:12, 15)? What difference does the birth of Christ have on your laughter during this Advent season (Lk. 2:10-14; Gal. 3:16)?
